**CITYCYCLE DECOMMISSIONING PROJECT
ALBERT STREET MALL, CBD**

Brisbane City Council would like to advise that CityCycle Stations along Albert Street Mall will be decommissioned and removed from mid-September 2021. CityCycle Stations include No. 12 & 13 near **Adelaide Street, CBD** and No. 14 & 15 near **Elizabeth Street, CBD**.

These works are part of a rolling program to phase out the CityCycle scheme and deliver more modern travel options that meet the needs of our growing city, with the introduction of new shared e-bikes and e-scooters on 22 July 2021.

Works will be undertaken at night, **between 7pm and 7am Monday to Friday**, when traffic volumes are lowest to ensure the safety of pedestrians, road users and workers.

Works at CityCycle Stations 12 & 13 near Adelaide Street will occur first and take approximately seven days to complete, weather and site conditions permitting. Works at CityCycle Stations 14 & 15 near Elizabeth Street will follow and take approximately seven days to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

During this time works to remove the CityCycle Station will include:

- saw-cutting and jack-hammering to pull apart elements of the station
- removal of the existing concrete around the station
- reinstatement of site area to match existing surfaces (as close as practical).

While a section of Mall will be closed for the works, pedestrian, vehicle and business access will be maintained. However, motorists and pedestrians should expect some delays. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists through the area.

While works are underway you may experience short-term construction impacts such as increased noise, dust and low-level vibrations from some equipment. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause and appreciate your patience while works are completed.
