

Rescheduled: North Brisbane Bikeway Stage 4 – Construction work on Price Street

September 2021

Dear Stakeholder,

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that works on the traffic island north of Price Street were delayed and are now scheduled to commence from 6 September 2021 and are expected to be completed within a week, weather and site conditions permitting.



Timing:

- Construction will commence from 6 September 2021, and are scheduled to be completed within a week, weather and site conditions permitting.
- The construction hours of night shifts will be from **7pm – 5am, Sunday to Thursday**.



Expected impacts:

Night shift:

- Changed traffic conditions including signage, reduced speed limits, detours, lane or shoulder closures
- There will be minor delays during construction, including a short delay for residents accessing their properties. Please allow extra time when planning your travel.
- Nearby residents and businesses will experience temporary short-term impacts including noise, dust, vibration and lighting from construction equipment and on-site activities. Excessive noise activities will only be carried out in the first half of the night.
- Every effort will be made to minimise impacts on the local community and surrounds. TMR appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are carried out.
